About CATALISI

CATALISI is an EU-funded project with the overall aim to help and support Higher Education Institutions to successfully implement a strategy and individual pathway for institutional transformation through the adoption of acceleration services. These are designed to facilitate and accelerate institutional transformations in the field of Research and Innovation which will strengthen European Universities collaborations and alliances as lighthouses of European values. CATALISI will analyse how the governance of Higher Education Institutions can be changed, considering the governance as a way in which societal and state actors intentionally interact in order to transform Science Technology and Innovation systems, by regulating issues of societal concern.

Activities foreseen within CATALISI include:

- Counselling and mentoring services throughout the process of HEI institutional transformation;
- Living labs and Mutual Learning workshop;
- Creation of market-based opportunities (i.e. identification of funding schemes, collaborations and alliances, opportunities for researchers to commercialise their research results);
- Peer to peer activities for human capital and capacity building development (mapping needs and providing innovative education design methods and approaches);
- Enhancement of HEI digitalization and Open Science access.

About the Community of Practice

The CATALISI Community of Practices (CoP) will be composed by a group of people, belonging to different sectors, who share common interests, valuable and different expertise and experience in institutional transformation in HEIs. Members of the CoP will engage in joint activities and discussions, and will share experience to build collective knowledge in their shared domain of interest.

The role of CoP is to feed the project activities with relevant expertise, methods, stories, tools and documents/publications, providing advice and guidance for the transformation of Higher Education Institution's governance, while simultaneously benefiting from the knowledge generated by CATALISI. In this way the CoP will create a safe learning environment that allows people to learn by doing. The CoP will be supported by a knowledge sharing online platform that will maintain the community alive.

CoP members will be selected from the categories of: education and research, digitalization and ICT, marketing, policy-makers, funding Organisations, civil society.

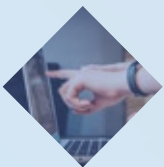
