Lifelong learning is a form of self-initiated education that is focused on personal development.

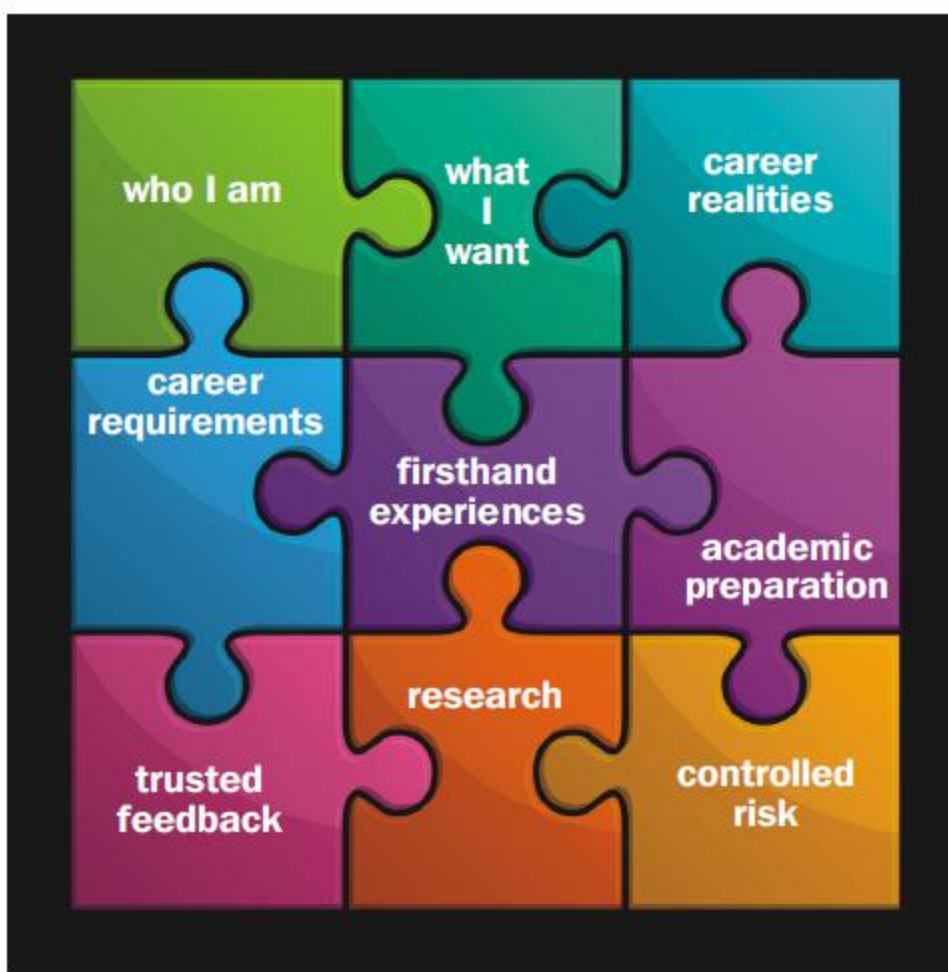


CAREER

¿WHAT ARE TRANSVERSAL SKILLS?

Transversal or **soft skills** are personal skills that go beyond technical knowledge and are based on adaptation to changing environments.

Thus, they are closely related to emotional intelligence and the ability to communicate and must be combined with hard skills, more related to performing a specific task.

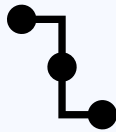
Next steps
