### SABINA PELLIZZONI - Gender Monitoring Programme INFN



Sabina is a technologist at INFN (National Institute for Nuclear Physics), and she is the coordinator Gender Mentoring programme INFN: the first gender mentoring in an Italian research institution. Sabina is INFN Team member for GENERA Network: originated from the EU-funded GENERA project and its vision is to support, coordinate and improve gender equality policies in physics research organizations in Europe and world-wide. Sabina is external expert of the GETA Observatory CNR IRPPS: for updating and analysing data and monitoring gender balance issues.

### EWA ŁOJKOWSKA and MAGDALENA ŻADKOWSKA – University of Gdańsk



Ewa is Professor at Intercollegiate Faculty of Biotechnology at the University of Gdańsk and Medical University of Gdańsk, Specialist of plant biotechnology and molecular plant pathology and Chair of the Committee on Biotechnology of the Polish Academy of Sciences. Chair of the Jury of the L'ORÉAL-UNESCO Award for Women and Science and member of the Jury of the L'ORÉAL-UNESCO International Rising Talents competition.



Magdalena is an Assistant professor in Sociology Institute at the Faculty of Social Sciences at the University of Gdańsk, Principal Investigator, Academic Teacher, Expert, focused on women and men carriers in STEM, diversity management, intimate relations and gender studies. Cooperates in international research projects with Norway, USA, Canada, UK, Italy, Romania, Chile and France.
