Context and Rationale

CATALISI, Accelerate Future HEI and **aUPaEU** are three sister projects funded under the same Horizon Europe topic: HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ERA-01-51.

- Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) as **drivers of change** in alignment with the **European Research Area (ERA)** objectives and the **Higher Education Transformation Agenda**
- EC pushes to take action by **developing strategies, tools** and **services** that can help HEIs in drawing up **roadmaps** for institutional changes contributing to a **new governance framework** responding to societal missions



To respond to this call, the 3 projects are developing and piloting concrete **acceleration services** and **institutional transformation models** to help HEIs modernise their structures and embrace ERA priorities, by ultimately contributing to **ERA Action 13**, *Empower Higher Education Institutions to develop in line with the ERA*

CATALISI Aim

To help and support Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to successfully implement a strategy and individual pathway for institutional transformation through the adoption of 7 innovative **acceleration services**.

These acceleration services are designed to facilitate and accelerate institutional transformations in the field of R&I with the ultimate aim of **strengthening European universities collaborations across regions** to maximize the value of research and its impact, to govern the transformations affecting science and innovation, to produce and disseminate high-quality knowledge.

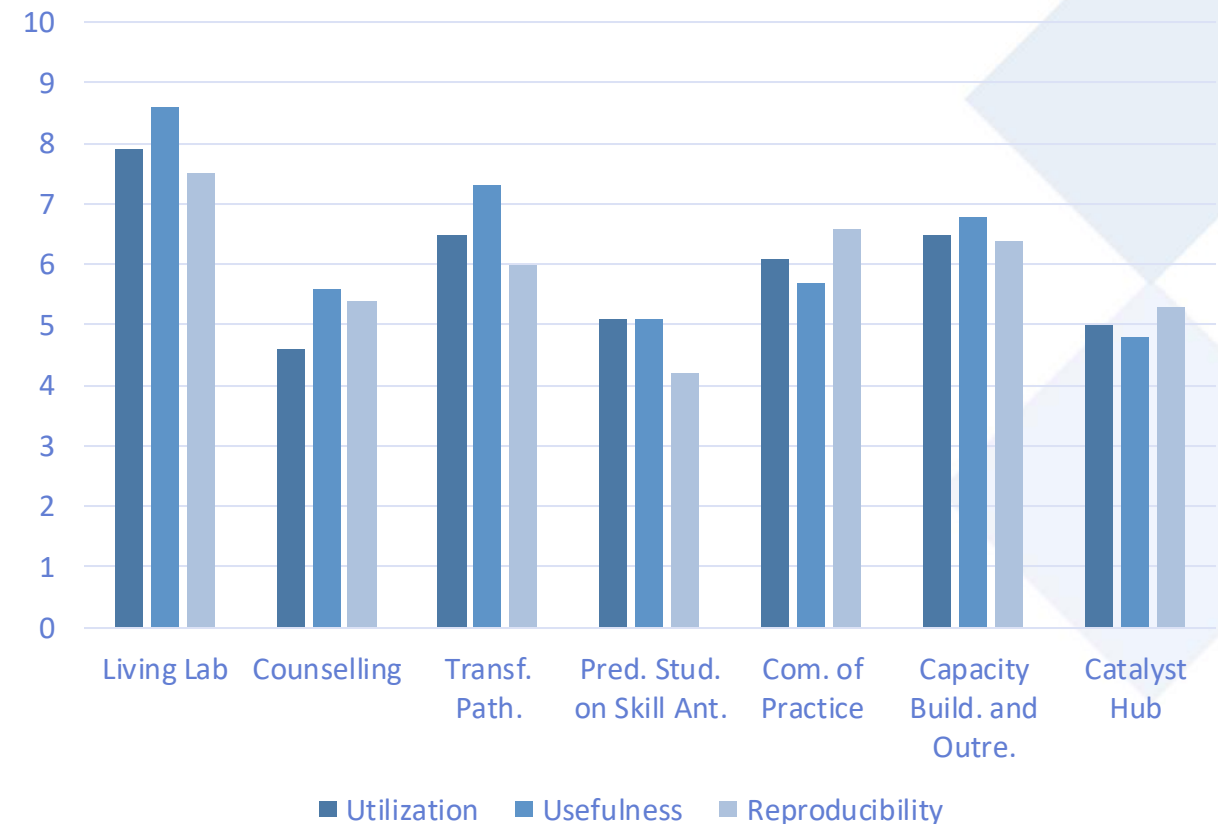




Results & success factors

- **86%** of activities in HEIs action plans were integrated at a university-wide (strategic level).
- **6 out of the 7** HEIs received support from department heads in conducting their actions; **5 out of 7** received support at a vice-rector/vice-president level.
- Facilitating Partners played a **key supporting role**, offering methodological guidance, administrative assistance, and strategic mentoring.
- Importance of **cross-institutional learning, cultural change and capacity building**.
- **Unanticipated outcomes** emerged, including new collaborations, new funding streams (Interreg), and stakeholder engagements (AUMC, UCC, UJI Survey), etc.

Utilization, usefulness and reproducibility of the CATALISI Acceleration Services (All Partners) - mean average scores 0 to 10.



Key takeaways

- CATALISI contributed to **positive institutional transformation** across participating HEIs, with a range of **tangible achievements**/transformations in the 7 case studies
- CATALISI has proven an **excellent testbed** for the experiment and trial-in-use of Acceleration Services: integration of new frameworks, and adoption of co-creation methodologies.
- → **Yet ...** Institutional change in line with the ERA is a **complex, multidimensional and timely** process for HEIs requiring the engagement of **ecosystems of actors and levers** from institutional, national, European contexts.

RECOMMENDATION: Shared definition and operational framework for acceleration services

EU level

- ❑ Promote modular and flexible acceleration service **frameworks** adapted to HEI needs.
- ❑ Develop a common typology and **taxonomy** of acceleration services.
- ❑ Potentially reduce number of acceleration services (**primary and secondary**), including clearer definitions and descriptions.

National level

- ❑ Provide practical guidance and **financial/policy instruments** that support institutions in deploying such services

HEIs/Alliances

- ❑ **Embed and prioritize** high-impact acceleration services in long-term governance and strategic planning, and not just treat them as project tools.
- ❑ More mutual learning, structured twinning and **in-person exchanges** to advance impact and collaboration
- ❑ **Support** other HEIs to replicate proven AS with guidance or mentoring

RECOMMENDATION: Prioritisation and focus of transformation efforts

EU level

- ❑ Future WIDERA calls should clearly define **key transformation domains** and promote phased approaches focused on high-priority areas.

National level

- ❑ Diagnostic and self-assessment tools to help HEIs **identify 3–5 priority areas** for transformation, aligning them with national and European strategic goals.

HEIs/Alliances

- ❑ Use internal action plans and strategic frameworks to select the domains with the **highest transformative potential**.
- ❑ Right balance between **ambition and realism** on what can be achieved during a period.
- ❑ **Narrow the focus** on a reduced number of intervention areas and domain
- ❑ **Align** transformation efforts to national reforms and EU frameworks for deeper change (e.g. DORA, CoARA frameworks).
